



## M.V Golden Jubilee NYE 2018 – All Inclusive

**Boarding time: 8.45pm**


**Boat's departure time: 9pm**

**From:** Temple Pier, Victoria Embankment WC2R 2PN

**Disembarking:** Temple Pier between 12.45 – 1am

Temple Pier is inside the restricted area cordoned off for the Mayors NYE fireworks and you will still require a boarding pass to gain access to the pier. In order to arrive on time for your party it is VERY important that you follow these instructions:

1. Leave a lot of extra time to get to the pier.
2. Travel by London Underground to **Temple Underground Station** and walk in the route shown below to the Pier. DO NOT try to walk from other stations. Do not travel into Central London via any other method than by London Underground Temple Station.
3. From Temple Underground station approach the pier via Arundel Street, then left onto Strand, then left onto Surrey Street. Once on Surrey Street, make your way to the front of the queue following the signs to **Red Entrance 4**.
4. Ensure that you and your guests all have their tickets and their boarding passes, (one printed per person) these will be needed not only to board the boat, but to get through security checks between Temple Station and Temple Pier.
5. Ensure all of your guests know the name of the boat they are boarding is **Golden Jubilee**. There will be other boats boarding at the same time from this pier.



Please note that CPBS takes no responsibility for late comers missing the boat and no refunds will be given should the boat leave before you arrive.

## Pre-Ordered Drinks:

If you have pre-ordered bottles of Champagne or Prosecco these will be served from the bar area at approximately 11.30pm<sup>5</sup>. Please give your full name and your order details to the bar staff onboard.

If you would like to pre-order Champagne please contact the office for details on 01689 898959. All orders must be received and fully paid by Friday 21<sup>st</sup> December 2018.

1. Food will be served between 9.30-10pm. The food has been intentionally designed as bowl food that can be eaten standing or seated.
2. Beers, wine by the glass, spirits with mixer and soft drinks are included in the ticket price.
3. Bottles of wine, Prosecco and Champagne will also be available for purchase on the night if required.
4. On the night our Captain will endeavour to moor the boat in the best possible spot to view the fireworks, however please note that the mooring options are tide and weather dependant. The boat may also moor up well before midnight which could cut down your actual cruising time. Please note we are restricted to certain areas of the river for health and safety reasons and the section of the Thames directly in front of the London Eye is completely closed to river traffic during the display, therefore we will be moored the other side of a bridge. We will position ourselves in the best possible place available to view the fireworks, however please note that the view will not be as seen on tv.
5. Should you wish to have these pre-ordered drinks at a different time a request should be made via our office on 01689 898959 by Friday 21<sup>st</sup> December 2018.

## Other information:

Dress code is smart casual, all passengers must be over the age of 21.

There is no reserved seating onboard our vessels. There is fixed bench seating in the saloon on the lower deck along with additional chairs and tables. As this is a disco cruise it is not anticipated that guests will wish to remain seated for the duration.

There are two female toilets onboard the vessel along with urinals for the men and 1 cubicle toilet.

There is a coat rail onboard but no secure cloakroom for coats or bags of any kind.

We advise all passengers to leave additional time to travel to the pier due to general congestion and police crowd control measures in Central London on NYE. We advise all passengers to travel by London Underground to Temple Station. You can check travel information and plan your route on the Transport for London website <http://www.tfl.gov.uk/plan-a-journey/>

In the interests of safety we ask passengers to remain at the top of the pier until your boarding time. At this time a member of staff will notify passengers that the boat is ready to board. Please ensure that each person has their ticket ready to show to staff upon boarding the vessel. It does take some time for everyone to board so we ask that you remain patient, we will get everyone onboard as soon as we can.

We aim to leave the pier promptly at 9pm. We hope that you have a fantastic evening onboard the Golden Jubilee and wish you all a very happy new year.




## Golden Jubilee Boat Plans
