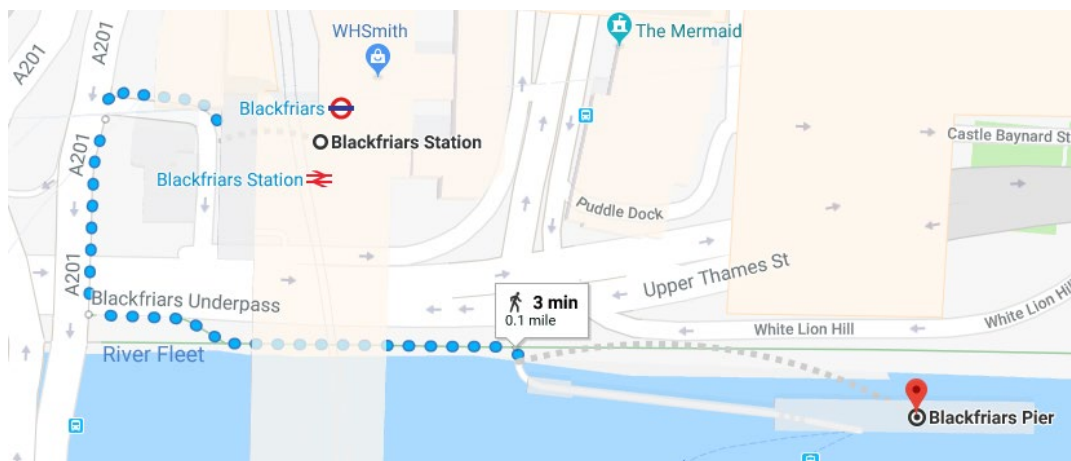

Blackfriars Millennium Pier is just outside the restricted area cordoned off for the Mayors NYE fireworks, however you will still require a boarding pass to gain access to the pier. In order to arrive on time for your party it is VERY important that you follow these instructions:

1. Leave a lot of extra time to get to the pier.
2. Travel by London Underground/ British Rail to **Blackfriars Underground/Rail Station** and walk in the route shown below to the Pier. DO NOT try to walk from other stations, should you try to walk through the cordoned areas you will not be permitted through to Blackfriars Millennium Pier. Do not travel into Central London via any other method than by London Underground or British Rail to Blackfriars Station.
3. Turn left out of the station onto Blackfriars Bridge. Once on the bridge, and just before you reach the river, turn left and use the stairs or lift to access the embankment and the pier.
4. Ensure that you and your guests all have their tickets and their boarding passes, (one printed per person) these will be needed not only to board the boat, but to get through security checks between Blackfriars Station and Blackfriars Pier.
5. Ensure all of your guests know the name of the boat they are boarding is **Golden Star**. There will be other boats boarding at the same time from this pier.



Please note that CPBS takes no responsibility for late comers missing the boat and no refunds will be given should the boat leave before you arrive.

Pre-Ordered Drinks:

If you have pre-ordered bottles of Champagne or Prosecco these will be served from the bar area at approximately 11.30pm ³. Please give your full name and your order details to the bar staff onboard.

Pre-ordered drinks vouchers are available at the bar, please give the bar staff your full name and the number of vouchers ordered.

If you would like to pre-order drink vouchers and/or Champagne please contact the office for details on 01689 898959. All orders must be received and fully paid by Friday 21st December 2018.

1. A complimentary glass of fizz or drink of your choice can be claimed at the bar – one per person
2. On the night our Captain will endeavour to moor the boat in the best possible spot to view the fireworks, however please note that the mooring options are tide and weather dependant. The boat may also moor up well before midnight which could cut down your actual cruising time. Please note we are restricted to certain areas of the river for health and safety reasons and the section of the Thames directly in front of the London Eye is completely closed to river traffic during the display, therefore we will be moored the other side of a bridge. We will position ourselves in the best possible place available to view the fireworks, however please note that the view will not be as seen on tv.
3. Should you wish to have these pre-ordered drinks at a different time a request should be made via our office on 01689 898959 by Friday 21st December 2018.

Other information:

Dress code is smart casual, all passengers must be over the age of 21.

There is no reserved seating onboard the vessel. There is seating for approximately 48 onboard, as per the seating plan on the following page, however, as this is a disco cruise it is not anticipated that guests will wish to remain seated for the duration. Please do not attempt to reserve seats for the entire cruise.

There are two unisex toilets onboard the vessel. There is a small coat cupboard onboard, this is not manned and CPBS do not take responsibility for any items left here.

We advise all passengers to leave additional time to travel to the pier due to general congestion and police crowd control measures in Central London on NYE. We advise all passengers to travel by London Underground/British Rail to Blackfriars Underground/Rail Station. 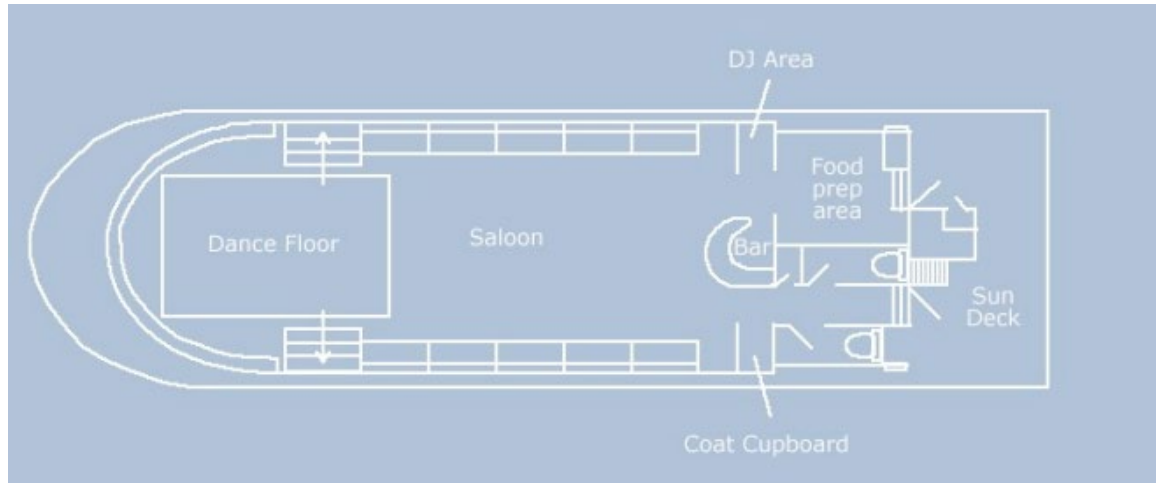

We aim to leave the pier promptly at 9pm. We hope that you have a fantastic evening onboard the Golden Star and wish you all a very happy new year!

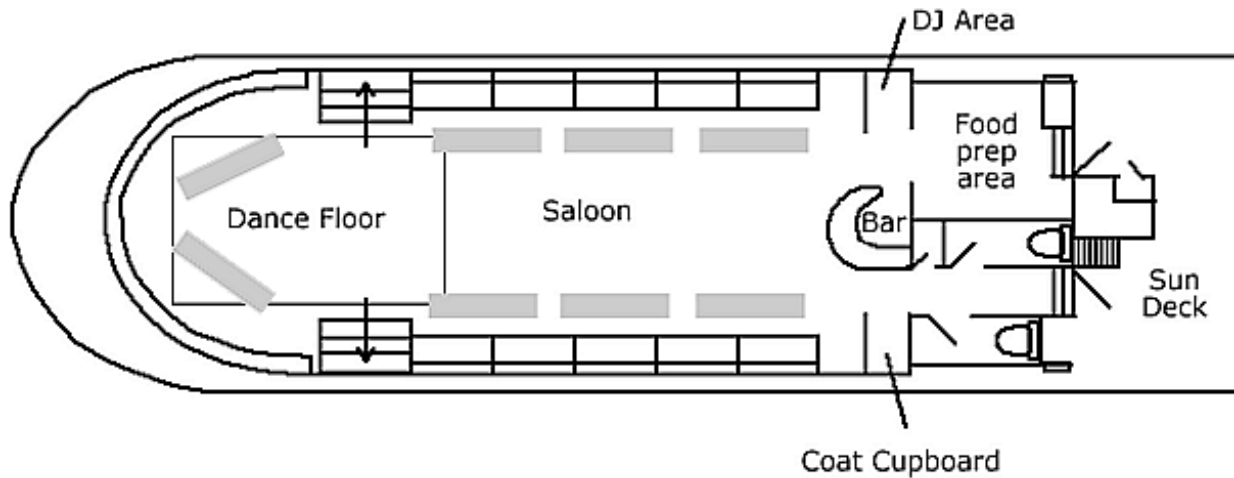
